- glass manipulators and glass setting devices
- worker health and safety
- disaster resistance
- blast protection

The GAC|CI also requires certified personnel to attain the Green Advantage Certified Practitioner™ (GACP™) or Green Advantage Certified Associate™ (GACA™) certification. As a result, the GAC|CI certification provides a powerful screening tool to building owners, architects, engineers, and contractors to assure that curtainwall installers possess the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to achieve best-in-class curtainwall installation and green construction objectives.

Preferential Bidding Document Language	
<i>Favorable rating (e.g., “points in bidder scoring”) will be granted when:</i>	
Minimal Preference	At least 30% of curtainwall installers possess the Green Advantage Curtainwall Installer (GAC CI) credential at least two weeks prior to their first scheduled workday.
Optimal Preference	At least 50% of curtainwall installers possess the Green Advantage Curtainwall Installer (GAC CI) credential at least two weeks prior to their first scheduled workday.
